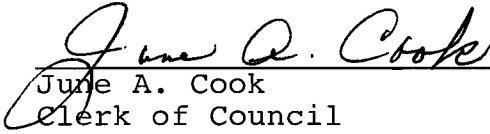
13. Ordinance No. C-80-90 (Plat of Meadow Grove East) was given its first reading. Second reading and public hearing will be on September 17.
