1. The Council of the City of Grove City met in regular session on the 17th day of December, 1990 at 8:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers, City Hall, with the following members present:

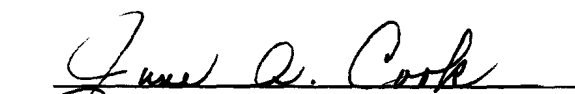

Mayor Stage said while traveling in other communities this holiday season, he has seen no other community as decorated as Grove City and is very proud to see such community effort and spirit. He also commended the Service Department on keeping the City clean, especially removing all the leaves.

Mayor Stage reminded everyone that Thursday, December 20, 1990 was the City employees luncheon and closed his comments with wishes of a Merry Christmas and Happy New Year.
