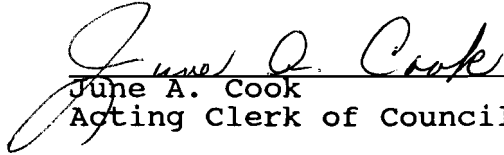

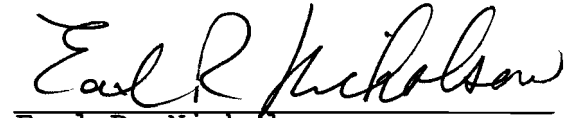
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announced the birth of Blaine Edward Kelly, infant son of Tami Kelly, Clerk of Council, and her husband Brian.
