May 06, 1991

Mr. Furgeson - Wanted to bring Council up-to-date on the Capital Music Center Committee. Said Capital Music was listening and changing the community and at this point, it was a wait and see kind of thing. The petition for the removal of the Liquor License against Capital Music Center is protected to House Bill 41. A copy of this House Bill was given to President Nicholson.

Mr. Brian Sullivan - Spoke on Capital Music Center. He wished to express his discontent for having "Guns & Roses" on the schedule for this season. He said he was a concert supervisor and had worked concerts where Guns & Roses played. He felt that they would be very bad for the community and that their vulgar language and loud music would be uncontrollable. He asked that Council follow Planning Commission's lead and vote down the Special Use Permit unless Guns & Roses was removed from the schedule or require Capital Music Center to provide a security bond to protect the City from the destruction that this band will cause.

Mr. Mike Smith - Rep. from Capital Music Center wished to address the Guns & Roses issue. He indicated that they had had specific experience with this band and have had no incidents. CMC is a professional organization and doesn't feel that there will be any problems with this band, however, they are always ready for every worst case scenario.

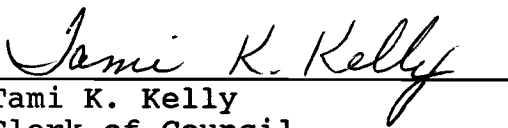
