COUNCIL MINUTES

April 03, 2017

Regular Meeting

The regular meeting of Council was called to order by President Schottke at 7:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers, City Hall, 4035 Broadway.

After a moment of silent prayer and the Pledge of Allegiance, roll was called and the following members were present:

1. Mr. Davis moved to excuse Mr. Robinette; seconded by Mr. Bennett.

2. Mr. Bennett moved to dispense with the reading of the minutes from the previous meeting and approve as written; seconded by Mr. Berry.

3. President Schottke recognized Mayor Stage who presented a Joint Proclamation for National Reach Out and Read month to Superintendent of SWCS, Dr. Wise, and School Board Member Lee Schreiner.
4. The Chair read the agenda items and they were approved by unanimous consent.

The Chair recognized Mr. Davis, Chairman of Finance, for discussion and voting under said Committee.

1. Ordinance C-12-17 (Authorize the City Administrator to enter into an Agreement with Spectrum for Voice Connectivity) was given its first reading. Second reading and public hearing will be held on 4/17/17.

The Chair recognized Mr. Berry, Chairman of Service, took the floor for discussion and voting under said Committee.

1. Resolution CR-10-17 (Declaring the Necessity of Constructing Certain Sidewalks in the City of Grove City and Requiring that Abutting Property Owners construct same) was given its reading and public hearing.

Mr. Smith, Dir. of Law, explained that these properties are not part of the sidewalk program. These are streets where complaints have been filed and these property owners have not complied with the

notices from the Service Dept. He said this moves the process forward and requires them to do it or the City will do it for them.

Mayor Stage noted that these owners will be able to take advantage of the assessment in order to pay for the repairs over time.

There being no additional questions or comments, Mr. Berry moved it be approved; seconded by Mr. Bennett.

2. Resolution CR-11-17 (Intent to Appropriate Fee Simple Title for the Improvements to Stringtown Road) was given its reading and public hearing.

Mr. Smith, Dir. of Law, explained that this is for the widening of Stringtown Road and extension of water & sewer lines. He said most property owners have already agreed to provide the necessary easements/property for this improvement project. However, for those who haven't replied, this begins the process to take the needed property under State statute, which Mr. Smith explained.

The Chair recognized Mr. Bennett, Chairman of Lands, took the floor for discussion and voting under said Committee.

1. Ordinance C-13-17 (Authorizing the Annexation of 0.6+ acres of Property located on Stringtown Road from Jackson Township to the City of Grove City) was given its first reading. Second reading and public hearing will be held on 4/17/17.

Mr. Smith noted that as part of the Stringtown Road Improvements, the City is annexing just the roadway. He said there will be two more ordinances like this one to take in the road all the way to S.R. 104.

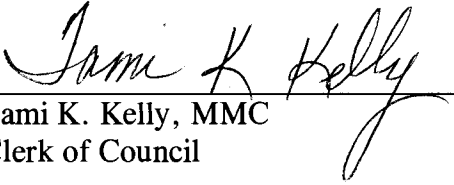
The Chair asked that any new business to be brought before the attention of Council be done so at this time.

1. Mr. Tom Chahine, Pres. of the S.W. Progressive Democrats; the Grove City Democrats; the Galloway Democrats and the Westside Democrats – representing 150,000, announced the creation of this Progressive Democratic Party and shared their mission.
2. Mr. Jarrod Brode, Boy Scout, was present to fulfill requirements for his merit badge for Citizenship in the Community.

The Chair recognized members of Administration and Council for closing comments.

1. Mayor Stage shared that the Police Chief spoke at a Hearing on the Beer/Wine Permit for One Stop Tobacco Shop. Currently, they are not selling alcohol at their new location. He then said he will be asking Council to pass a Resolution of opposition to H.B. 49 at their next meeting.
2. Ms. Kelly, Clerk of Council, reviewed the Liquor Permits for Hop Yard 62 and Chipotle on S.R. 665. There being no objections, Ms. Kelly will mark the notices accordingly.
3. President Schottke announced that Council would meet in Special Session to review and discuss the Charter Task Force recommendations on April 22 at 8:00 a.m.
4. After comments from Council and Administrative staff members, a motion to adjourn was approved by unanimous consent.

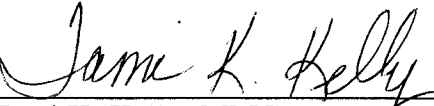
