1. The Council of the City of Grove City, Ohio met in regular session on the second day of April, 1990 at 8:00 p.m. in the Municipal Safety Building, 3360 Park Street with the following members present:

20. Ordinance No. C-37-90 (pay scale for police radio employees) was given its first reading. Second reading and public hearing will be on April 16.

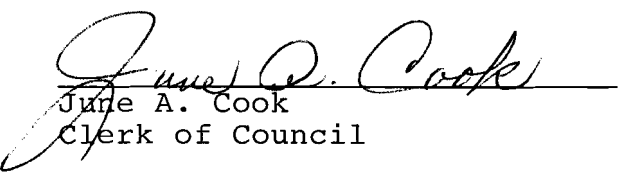

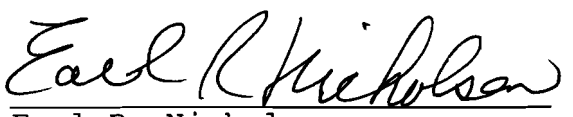
that the agreement for off-site parking was not filed, recorded nor binding.
