Speaking to Resolution CR-17-91, a resolution to waive provisions of Sec. 903.01(b) of the Codified Ordinances for the Annual Alumni Softball Tournament at Evans Park, was Mr. Babbert stating that this would allow the Sertoma Club to control the consumption of beer which has been done for the past two years and has received favorable results and a positive response from the area residents and police department.

Also speaking on this resolution was Mr. Steve Carr, Tournament Director, expecting 54 teams participating. From a business stand point, having the Sertoma Club running the concession is a big plus and would like to see it continue. Also thanked the City for its participation in diamond preparation, etc.

Also noted that the size of the cups would be smaller this year.

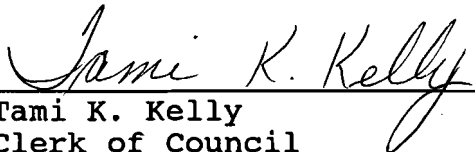

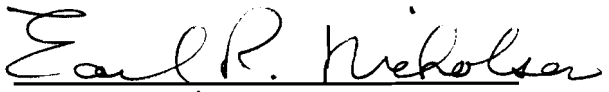
16. Mr. Nicholson moved that the Mayor's Report be accepted; seconded by Mr. Buckley.
