

CITY OF GROVE CITY, OHIO COUNCIL MINUTES

January 03, 1995

Regular Meeting

Prior to the regular meeting, Council met at 6:00 p.m., in open forum, with Mr. Frank Elmer of Elmer and Associates, to discuss the Concept Plan for the Grove City area.

The regular meeting of Council was called to order by President Grossman at 8:00 p.m. in the Council Chamber, City Hall, 4035 Broadway.

After a moment of silent prayer and the Pledge of Allegiance, roll was called and the following members were present:

1. Mr. Hurley moved to excuse Mr. Schreck and Mayor Stage; seconded by Mr. Warner.

2. Mr. Warner moved to dispense with the reading of the minutes and approve as written; seconded by Mr. Milovich.

3. President Grossman recognized Mr. Chris Fulton, Director of Safety, for a presentation.

Mr. Fulton welcomed Mr. Chris White and Mr. Doug Olmstead to the Grove City Police Department. He administered the Oath of Office to each as Patrolmen. They will begin the Academy next week.

The Chair recognized Mr. Hurley, Chairman of the Lands & Zoning Committee for discussion and voting of legislative agenda items under said committee.

1. Ordinance C-1-95 (Rezone lots 93 and 94 of Woodlawn Addition located on Bruce Avenue from R-2 to PUD-R) was given its first reading. Second reading and public hearing will be held on February 06, 1995.

The Chair recognized Mr. Warner, Chairman of Service, for discussion and voting of legislative agenda items under said committee.

1. Ordinance C-92-94 (Amend Section 939.08(b) of the Codified Ordinances entitled Sewer Connections; Permit Required; Inspections; Fees and declare an emergency) was given its second reading and public hearing.

Mr. Warner explained that this was a pass through increase from the City of Columbus whereby we are required to remit at least one-third to them.

There being no additional questions or comments, Mr. Warner moved that the Rules of Council be suspended and the waiting period waived; seconded by President Grossman.

2. Resolution CR-1-95 (Sponsor a contest to create an Artistic Design for the Grove City Water Tower located on State Route 665 and I-71) was given its reading and public hearing.

Mr. Milovich explained that this water tower is a prominent figure in its area and since it is in a situation of needing maintenance and painted. He has been working with Mr. Ray Kline, Art Concern Consultant, to come up with some type of artistic design painted on the Tower. With that, the hope is to set up a contest, primarily for Grove City High School students, and put together three different placements for prizes to come up with a favorable design. He hopes to see it painted in August, 1995. Mr. Kline also elaborated on how this type of artistic design will enhance the community. It will provide the students with a little money and some recognition.

There being no additional questions or comments, Mr. Warner moved it be approved; seconded by Mr. Milovich.

Resolution CR-2-95 (Authorize the Mayor to enter into a Funding Agreement for the improvement of Grant Avenue) was given its reading and public hearing.

Mr. Warner explained that the City has been awarded a \$200,000.00 Housing and Community Development Block Grant for the improvement of Grant Avenue and a funding agreement must be executed with Franklin County on January 10, 1995.

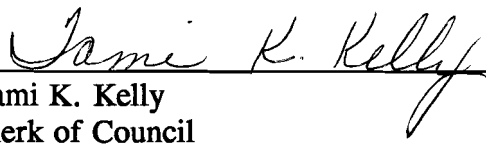
President Grossman asked that any new business to be brought before the attention of Council be done so at this time.

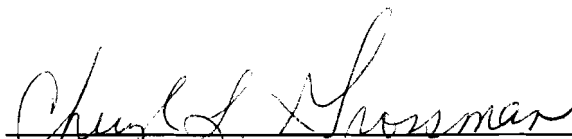
