**BICYCLE TRANSPORTATION TASK FORCE**  
**MINUTES**

September 07, 2023

Regular Meeting

1. The regular meeting of the Bicycle Transportation Task Force was called to order at 6:05 p.m. in the Council Conference Room in City Hall, 4035 Broadway. Roll was called and the following members were present:

2. Mr. Daniels moved to approve the 08/17/23 minutes as written; seconded by Mr. Tampurages. Unanimously approved.
3. Mr. Daniels submitted a draft Council report to all the members last night and asked for feedback from the Task Force. He also asked if it was the Task Force's job to include information on cost estimates. Ms. Fitzpatrick explained that it would be the job of the consulting engineer to do that, down the road.
4. The Task Force reviewed the mapped out and color -coded interior routes through Grove City which include:
  1. Buckeye Pkwy @ 665 to White to Keller Farms out McDowell north to Southwest east to Gantz north to I-270 (Green)
  2. Fryer to Southern Grove to Holton Run the GC Inn north on Broadway to Babbert Way alley (already signed) to TC (Red)
  3. CC Campus to Southwest Blvd to McDowell south to White to Buckeye Pkwy to Pinnacle Club to SR 104 to Scioto Grove Metro (Blue)
  4. Hoover Park Pond on 62 south to Demorest Dr. through Holton Run & Hoover Park to Haughn to Murfin through the Highschool to Hoover to Gershwin through Briarwood to White to Buckeye Parkway to Pinnacle Club to SR 104 to Scioto Grove Metro (Yellow)
  5. Fryer Park east to Hoover (future ped bridge to Pinnacle Park Dr dashed) south to Holton east to Buckeye Parkway (Magenta)
  6. Bill Lotz Way & 665 east to N Meadows north to Marv Holt Trail east to Quail Creek to Buckeye Parkway (Orange) include alternate route that goes 665 all the way to Hoover and then north to Quail Creek
  7. Bill Lotz Way future trail to Fryer to Southern Grove to Holton Run (Demorest Rd) out to 62 future trail to connect to Demorest Rd north through Tanglebrook to Southwest Blvd (Cyan)

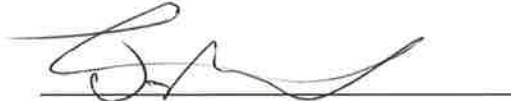
This will be an overlay to the current bicycle path map that the City currently has. Mr. Daniels said that he will add this map to the report once it is completed.

5. Ms. Fitzpatrick provided an update on the Bukey Road path. Grove City is meeting with the City of Columbus sometime in October for this. She also shared that a technical working group has been created (she is on the Southwest quadrant) to suggest transit supportive infrastructure projects for improvement. Lastly, Grove City is having a meeting to look at alternatives for quarry path access, possibly Lockbourne Rd.
6. Mr. Daniels asked, in preparation for the next meeting, that everyone get their comments on the report back to him by September 15<sup>th</sup>.
7. The next meeting will be on Thursday, September 21st at 6:00 p.m.
8. A motion was made to adjourn and was approved by unanimous consent.
