MINUTES

Regular Meeting

1. The regular meeting of the Grove City Community Diversity Advisory Task Force was called to order by Chair Reynolds at 6:00 p.m., in the City Hall Lower Level, 4035 Broadway. Roll was called and the following were present:

2. Ms. Anderson moved to approve the Minutes from 8/15/22; seconded by Ms. Stewart. Motion unanimously approved.
3. Chair Reynolds announced that Lotus Boes has resigned. Ms. Stewart moved to accept the resignation; seconded by Ms. Williams. Motion unanimously approved. (This position was an appointment by the Parks & Rec. Dept. and will need filled in the same manner.)
4. The Committee did a final reviewed the definitions and vision statements that were agreed to at the previous meeting. No changes were requested.
5. The Committee reviewed the Draft Press Release for the Listening Session and it was approved.

All agreed to set a date of 10/18/22 for receiving any forms.

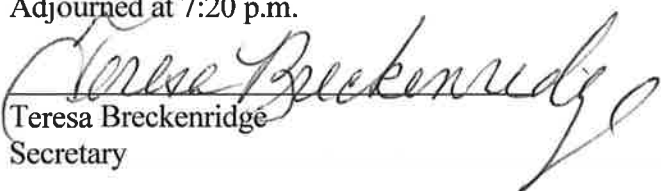
