April 17, 2023

Regular Meeting

A meeting of the Higher Education Investment Committee was called to order at 5:20 p.m. in the Council Conference Room, City Hall. Roll was called and the following members were present:

1. Ms. Schakat moved to approve the Minutes from 11/23/22; seconded by Mr. Perkins. Motion unanimously approved.
2. Chair Holt explained that the purpose of today's meeting was to approve the Summer, 2023 scholarships.

Ms. Kelly provided an overview of this semester and shared the details shown on the attached sheet.

Ms. Schakat moved to approve all applications, contingent upon receiving the required grades/volunteers hours from those in the Fall Program before an award was granted; and to approve the Skilled Trade application and approve payment to the student, per the terms of the program; seconded by Mr. Perkins. Motion unanimously approved.

3. Unfinished Business:

Ms. Kelly said the Law Director was unable to attend this meeting, but they have talked and he will be sending letters out to the delinquent students in the program.

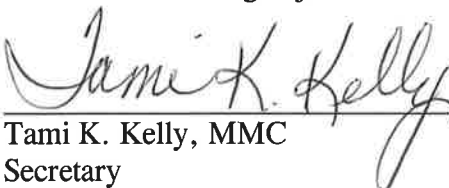

Ms. Kelly announced that Mr. Hampson submitted an e-mail today stating that he could no longer serve on this Committee and thanked everyone for allowing him to be a part. She said Mr. Hampson was a Council appointee and will get with the Council Members to have a new person appointed.

Ms. Schakat announced that she has resigned from South-Western City Schools and will be moving out of State at the end of the school year. Everyone thanked her for her excellent service to this committee and, while she will be sorely missed, wished her well in her new endeavor.
