BICYCLE TRANSPORTATION TASK FORCE
MINUTES

May 23, 2024

Regular Meeting

1. The regular meeting of the Bicycle Transportation Task Force was called to order at 6:06 p.m. in the Council Conference Room of City Hall, 4035 Broadway. Roll was called and the following members were present:

2. Mr. Daniels moved to approve the 04/18/24 minutes; seconded by Mr. Davison. Motion unanimously approved.
3. Karen Fahy, Information Relations, shared updates made to the Task Force's webpage. The page is currently under 'Our Residents' on the City's website but will also be added to 'Our Visitors'. They will be adding the new bike path map to the webpage as well. She said they will start promoting the Slow Roll, bike rides done through Heritage Cycle, which will begin on June 19th at 6:00 p.m. She asked the Task Force to go through the webpage at their leisure and provide feedback and any recommendations they have.
4. Kim Sheilds, Development Dept., explained that they are trying to gain public input through surveys for the Active Transportation Plan. She presented the Task Force with example maps from other cities that focus on the safety of routes and asked members to choose their favorite. Members chose the Wilmington, North Carolina map. Mr. Tampurages said that he liked how the freeways on the Wilmington map were black and stood out. Her department wishes to create another map for the Task Force that outlines the safety and comfortability of our bikeways, considering traffic and speed of motorists. She wants the new map to highlight main routes through subdivisions, recommended routes, and 2-4 comfort levels.

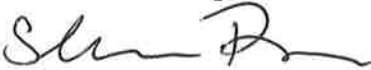
Mr. Daniels suggested that development make sure to add the date on all maps and make interstates, like I-71, more prominent so that they can be used as landmarks.

Ms. Sheilds explained that she will take the routes the Task Force identified and will create a colorless map for the next meeting, and they can color code it themselves and mark it up as they see fit. She will also provide additional traffic/road data to aid in the activity.

She will send out an invitation to members for the June 4th stakeholder meeting regarding the Active Transportation Plan.
