

**CITY OF GROVE CITY, OHIO
BICYCLE TRANSPORTATION TASK FORCE
MINUTES**

March 20, 2024

Regular Meeting

1. The regular meeting of the Bicycle Transportation Task Force was called to order at 6:00 p.m. in the Council Conference Room of City Hall, 4035 Broadway. Roll was called and the following members were present:

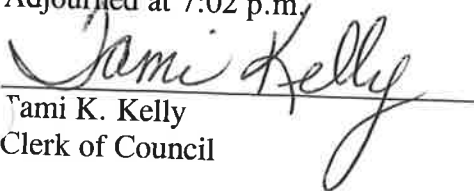

2. There being no quorum, no action was taken.
3. Ms. Fitzpatrick reported that: She has received the Scope of Services from the engineer for the Camp Chase Trail (Holt Road through Bolton Airport). She has sent this to Columbus for review and to partner on, in anticipation of applying to MORPC for funding; there was a kick-off meeting for alternate analysis & a feasibility study for the pedestrian bridge over I-71. There are two options being reviewed and she will share them with the Task Force when complete; the ODOT Active Transportation Plan is moving forward. No kick-off meeting yet; Kim Shields ordered the bicycle helmets and has asked for 72 of each of the larger sizes and 32 for the small size; the Bike Map is still a work in progress and will be brought to this group soon; MORPC selected the Feasibility Study for the trail up to I-270 (linking to the Scioto Trail) as part of the Link-Us program.
4. Ms. Kelly announced that Richie Cohen-Smith has tendered his resignation on the Task Force. He was appointed by the Ward 4 Council Member and will be replaced in the same manner. Ms. Anderson has already been informed of the need for her appointment. If Task Force members know of any interested persons, they can have them submit their information to Ms. Kelly and she will pass it on the Council Member Anderson for consideration.
5. Chair Stamper updated the group on Ecofest. He said there will be a table with pamphlets; the old bike map if the new one isn't ready; bike activities. It will be held on 4/20 from 9:00 – 1:00. Members are invited to work the table at any time.
6. Mr. Davison asked about discussing the future of this Task Force at the next meeting. It was decided that the members would review the Resolution tasks assigned and discuss the future of the Task Force; get an update on the Bike USA application; and review the website. The next meeting will be on Thursday, April 18, 2024 at 6:00 p.m.
7. A motion was made to adjourn and was approved by unanimous consent.
