MINUTES

Regular Meeting

1. The regular meeting of the Grove City Community Diversity Advisory Task Force was called to order by Ms. Reynolds at 6:00 p.m., in the Council Conference Room, 4035 Broadway, Roll was called and the following were present:

2. There being no objections, the 07/08/24 Minutes were approved by unanimous consent.
3. Members began by discussing the Year 1 Report and the recommendations made by the Task Force last year, to create provisions in the Zoning Code for affordable housing and hire a third party HR person to audit the City.

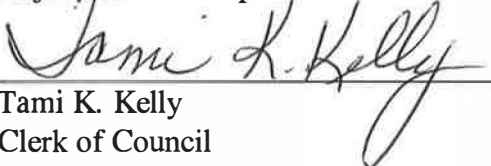
Mr. Downton suggested that they link the recommendations from the last report to the Year 2 Report. He wants to craft language that show the new recommendations are stemming from further exploration. He wants the community to know they are still listening to their input from the community survey and the listening sessions.

Mr. Jackson suggested changing the language in Recommendation 1 to take away partnering with the YMCA and change it to partnering with organizations and businesses within the Grove City community.

The Task Force discussed that the main focus of creating the new internal committee is to put the infrastructure for DEI work first. They changed the language in the recommendations to be less prescriptive, the City should have the freedom to place people in committee positions and it should not be dictated by the current Task Force in their recommendations.

4. They want to continue with Recommendation 3 at the next meeting and potentially look at a fourth. The next meeting will be on 09/09/24 at 6:00 p.m.
6. There being no objection, the meeting was ajourned by unanimous consent.
