BICYCLE TRANSPORTATION TASK FORCE
MINUTES

December 12, 2024

Regular Meeting

1. The regular meeting of the Bicycle Transportation Task Force was called to order at 6:00 p.m. in the Council Conference Room of City Hall, 4035 Broadway. Roll was called and the following members were present:

2. Mr. Stamper moved to approve the minutes from 11/14; seconded by Mr. Daniels. Unanimously approved.
3. Mr. Shannon Hamons, Dir. of Service, gave his update on the connection options to the Camp Chase Trail. He has met with EMH&T, and they pinpointed three potential routes: Johnson Rd., Alkire Rd., and Holt Rd. He will be meeting again with EMH&T to see what their best plan of attack is with property owners, cost estimates, etc. He also shared with the group that he will be meeting with the City of Columbus and the Airport Authority to map out the best route. By the end of January, Mr. Hamons said he should have a document ready for the Task Force to look at.
5. Ms. Shields, Development Dept., could not make it but provided the Task Force with a list of suggestions for things they could add to the back of the Active Transportation Map.

Mr. Stamper brought in and suggested adding the summary of Ohio Bike Laws and ABC Quick Check (Air, Brakes, and Chain). Members agreed and suggested adding correct attire and nighttime safety precautions as well. Mr. Daniels suggested adding the protocol for bike registration.
6. The Task Force asked for updates on the McDowell Rd. project, the pedestrian bridge over Gantz Rd., the Active Transportation Map, the Camp Chase Trail, the Hoover Rd. pedestrian bridge, the Beulah connector to Breck Park, and the bike path on Southwest Blvd by Jackson Township Fire at the next meeting.
7. The next meeting was set for February 6th, at 6:00 p.m., City Hall.
8. A motion was made to adjourn and was approved by unanimous consent.
