Regular Meeting

1. The regular meeting of the Bicycle Transportation Task Force was called to order at 6:07 p.m. in the Council Conference Room of City Hall, 4035 Broadway. Roll was called and the following members were present:

Members Absent: Sam Clark, James Daniels, Joey Hoffmann, Dan Starcher

2. Mr. Tampurages moved to approve the 05/01 and 06/03/25 Minutes; seconded by Mr. Belliveau. Motion unanimously approved.
3. The Task Force reviewed the original list of charges set forth in Resolution CR-03-23 for the Task Force and the following was determined:
 1. Identify connection points/routes to Darby Park/Camp Chase Trail & Downtown Columbus. The members believe this has been completed.
 2. Work with other communities/entities to invoke connectivity. The members feel this is ongoing and believe they can work with Metro Parks, MORPC, Columbus, etc.
 3. Focus on safe routes. The members believe this is on-going and should work with the City's Engineer on this item.
 4. Work with City's Engineer to provide cost estimates. The members believe this should be removed and combined with #3.
 5. Identify grants to assist in funding efforts. The members believe this should be removed as this is done by City Staff, MORPC, Metro Parks.
 6. Coordinate efforts with Bicycle Friendly America. This is ongoing and the members would like to remain included in the efforts to achieve the next level.
 7. Provide a report to Council by 9/7/2023. This is complete, with the report from October, 2023. However, the members would like to suggest changing this to read: Provide a report to Council on an annual basis.

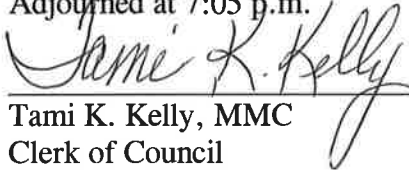
The members also suggested adding a couple of tasks:

- a. Promote Bike Safety along-side the City and review designs for new projects for safety.
- b. Promote mental and physical health through biking.

Mr. Belliveau moved to recommend that the Task Force request that the resolution be updated; seconded by Mr. Tampurages. Unanimously approved.

4. Mr. Dicken, representing Service Dept., provided an updated on the Scioto Grove/Great Southern Connector trail and passed out the latest map of the path.
