Regular Meeting

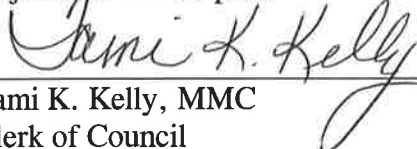
