MINUTES

April 23, 2026

Regular Meeting

1. The regular meeting of the CARES Healthcare Pilot Program Committee was called to order at 5:32 p.m. in the Council Conference Room of City Hall, 4035 Broadway. Roll was called and the following members were present:

2. Ms. Cahill moved to approve the minutes of the 03-18-26 meeting; seconded by Mr. Moore. Motion unanimously approved.
3. Members discussed the Council Meeting and thanked Mr. Moore for speaking on behalf of the Committee. They reiterated why they believed offering this to residents or individuals who work in Grove City better helps with the economic benefit of the program. Both pay either property or income tax to the City. They discussed creating a checklist or simple bullet points to easily explain the program. Mr. Berry said he is working on a paragraph to explain the economic development benefits of the program and will send that out for everyone to review.

Now that the appropriation of funds for the Pilot Program has been approved, they discussed how best to market it. This Pilot has a two-fold purpose: first, to assist our residents who struggle to pay for health insurance, and next, to help small businesses that cannot supply insurance to employees, offer this program as a way to secure or maintain their workforce. Sending flyers to certain employers and certain insurance brokers; creating a webpage on the City's website; using social media and e-mails were all ideas suggested for marketing the program.

Members reviewed the Draft Flyer and found it to be acceptable. Ms. Kelly said she would work with Community Relations to work on marketing.

Ms. Cahill suggested changing the name from healthcare to health insurance in the future. She said although people interchange these phrases, this program is strictly helping with insurance premiums and not co-pays or other healthcare expenses. The Members agreed.

4. A motion to adjourn was approved by unanimous consent. The next meeting will be May 20, 2026.
