Regular Meeting

1. The regular meeting of the Bicycle Transportation Task Force was called to order at 6:10 p.m. in the Council Conference Room of City Hall, 4035 Broadway. Roll was called and the following members were present:

Members Absent: Mark Davison, Dan Starcher, Jeff Ritchie, Anna Vagades

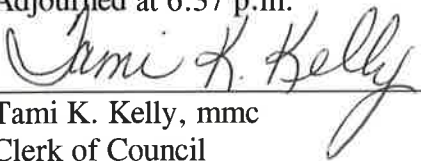
Staff Support: Shannon Hamons, Kim Shields, Tami Kelly

2. Mr. Hamons shared that the trail by Century Village on Orders Road is a mess and Columbia Gas is coming back to fix it. Temporary stone should be installed tomorrow and permanent repairs will take place in a couple of weeks. He also reported that the Hoover Road Bridge project has been awarded to Eagle Bridge Co. and is set to start in May.

Mr. Stamper confirmed that Mr. Hamons received his e-mail with the maps of cut-outs on Southwest Blvd. He said there is another spot on Hoover Road, by Christina's Villas that he will send over this week.

3. Ms. Shields said she put in an application in to the "Put a Lid on It" program for two boxes of children's size helmets. She said they will come in after Eco-fest, but could be used for the Safety Dept. E-Scooter Training events. Ms. Shields then updated the Committee on *Celebrate Trail Day*, hosted by Rails and Trails. She said this is the week after Eco-fest and requested some handouts and materials so it could be promoted during Eco-fest. Ms. Shields then discussed World Day Remembrance to honor bicycle and walking victims of road traffic. She said the Parks & Rec. Dept. is open to having an event for this, but ask the Committee to brainstorm some ideas. Finally, she said the Bikeway Map will be updated this year and it was suggested that the known upcoming trails be shown with dashed lines and a possible QR Code that would give more information.
4. Mr. Stamper moved to approve the 02-05-26 Minutes; seconded by Mr. Belliveau. Motion unanimously approved.
5. There being no additional business, a motion to adjourn was approved by unanimous consent. The next meeting will be April 02, 2026.
