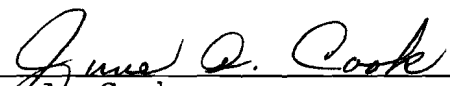
23. Mayor Stage gave his report for the month of October and Mr. Nicholson moved it be accepted; seconded by Mr. Mountain.

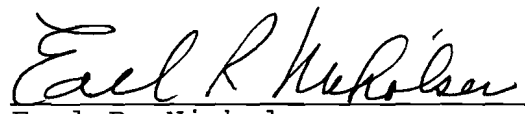
