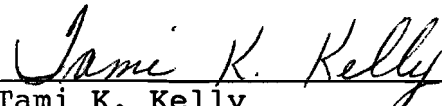
13. Mr. Nicholson moved to accept the Mayor's Report; seconded by Mr. Mountain.
